- **Shift Times:** Saturday and/or Sunday - 11am-2pm or 2-5pm
- **Schedule:** 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> or 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> weekend of the month
